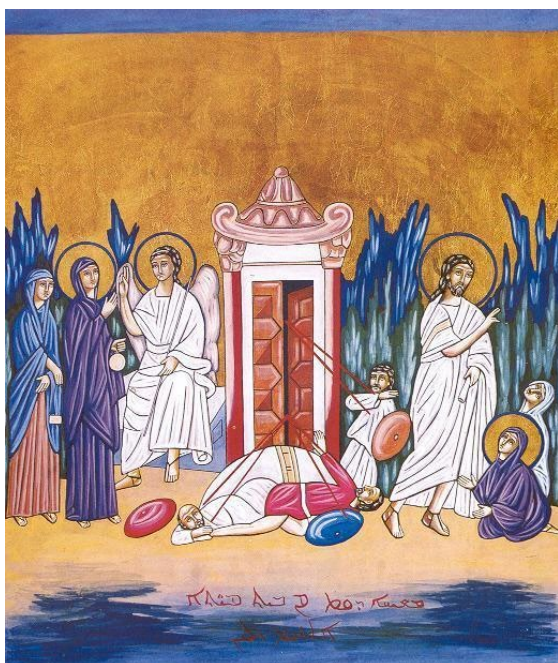

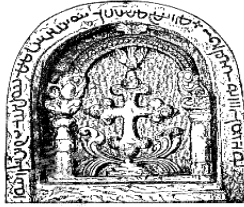
Liturgical Resource Development

<p style="text-align: center;">THE ORDER OF THE VENERATION OF THE CROSS</p>
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At the Conclusion of the 1st Service of the Resurrection, which is performed quietly at the tomb (in the altar) with the curtain veiled, the celebrant holds the cross high and proclaims:

Priest: My brethren, I bring you new glad tidings: Christ has risen from the tomb and has struck His enemies behind Him! (x3)

People: We believe and confess that He has indeed risen! (x3)

HYMN

*Sung during the procession
(Qum Paulos – Tone 1/O Mariyaame Njaan)*

“Behold, O Mary – I am the Gardener;
I am the Great One – who planted – paradise;
Behold, O Mary – I am the Revival,
The Resurrection, – and the Life – of all things
Mary, I am He – Who was crucified.
Do not come near Me, – for I have not ascended,
But go and announce – to all the Apostles
That I have risen – from the tomb – in glory.”

When the procession returns to the altar, the celebrant puts the cross on the stand, and starts the Service of Giving Peace.

OPENING PRAYER

† Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

May His mercy and compassion be upon us, / weak and sinful, / in both worlds forever and ever. / Amin.

Priest: O Christ our God, Who endured sufferings and the Cross on account of our salvation, Who died of His own will and quickened our mortality, Who rose from the tomb and raised us with Him, grant us, O Lord, to rejoice on this glorious feast of Your Resurrection. Make Your tranquility and peace to dwell among us. Visit us with the mercies of Your grace, cure our sickness and our illness by Your clemency. Deliver us from the afflictions and punishment of wrath, by Your Compassion, so that we may rejoicingly celebrate Your feast, our Lord and our God, forever.

People: Amin

[Psalm 51] Have mercy on me, O God, in Your loving kindness; / in the abundance of Your mercy blot out my sin.

Wash me thoroughly from my guilt and cleanse me from my sin, / for I acknowledge my fault and my sins are before me always.

FINAL BENEDICTION

Priest: May the beginning and end of this Holy Lent be blessed and may God help and assist you all who observed the fast to the end according to His will. May He break the snares of Satan, the visible and invisible enemy who is the adversary of faithful Christians, and deliver you from his temptations as our Lord Jesus defeated him at the end of His fast, saying to him “ Be gone Satan, get you behind me”. Through the prayers of St. Mary, the holy Theotokos, and of all the Saints may you be preserved and supported by the power of the victorious Cross forever and ever.

People: Amin

The Celebrant signs the congregation with the cross. The clergy and deacons immediately enter the sanctuary. They bless themselves by kissing the altar, the cross, the Gospel, and the holy tomb and the saints' relics. The clergy give the kiss of peace to each other. The deacons receive blessings from the clergy, and then give peace to one another.

Then, the Archdeacon cries out saying:

Deacon: Let us give peace to one another with a holy and divine kiss.

One of the deacons goes and spreads the kiss of peace to the congregation. After the cross is brought down to the chancel for veneration, the following hymns shall be sung.
